


















# RESEARCH ASSET

Gender history is very necessary in theory and in daily practice to establish a reality that is governed by equal conditions.


Starting from the study and research on anti-fascist women in the 1930s (among other more recent women's history topics such as the pacifist movement in the 1980s, very necessary especially now) this initiative tries to achieve a double objective:

- Disseminate knowledge and gender perspective in teaching and research activities in university teaching
- Get this content and its application outside of university classrooms by participating in exhibitions, talks at schools, and not only research but also outreach projects.

The Connection and transfer of knowledge in secondary school (by giving talks and conferences) and in political praxis (by participating in acts that keep the memory of history always alive) seeks that History does not remain in the academy.
